Proceedings:

- Meeting called to order by VP Tim Mallinak.at 7:08.
- No new members are in attendance.
- AFF oct 7,8,9. Sixty to seventy refs needed. If you have not contacted Tim or put in an application, please do.
 - Two assessors will be provided. If you are interested in upgrading, please ensure you are in the upgrade program. Your paperwork must first be submitted before you may have an upgrade assessment. Developmental assessments are also available. Contact Tim with any questions.
- Scott Walsh announced there will be a directive regarding uniform for TSSAA referees.
 - He noted: only the three stripe sock is permitted. Only a solid black hat may be worn. No sunglasses should be worn unless they are prescription. Also note, the hat is not permitted during USSF. Also, in both cases the shoe should be predominantly black.
- Reminder to see the amendment to the concussion policy (link/or include).
- Also, reminder that the TSSAA Heat Index Policy should still be adhered to, and that the water breaks are a minimum of five minutes.
- Carl, Tony, and Scott gave a presentation on referring the two-man system.
 - Two man responsibilities for pregame are still the same. Both referees share all responsibilities, and must determine how to divide the responsibilities during play so there is no miscommunication.
 - Who has the clock
 - How is the field divided

- Agree on advantage v calling the foul
 - Agree how to communicate to prevent showing disagreement (ex. Agree that whoever is closest is responsible for advantage calls, agree who will display cards in a given situation- usually the closest).
 - Mirror calls.
 - Agree on small discrete signals for the Trail to give assistance to the Lead for goal kick/corner kick, so the Lead official may still make that call. The trail then mirrors.
 - The trail referee should be even with the ball. He also covers placement, encroachments, and delays during kicks and restarts.
 - The lead moves ahead for the play.
 - Switch quadrants (sides) for second half. (Do not switch ends).
 - Drop balls are taken by the trail referee.
 - Note: Your game will not be sanctioned in USSF if it is a two man, and you will assume all liability.
